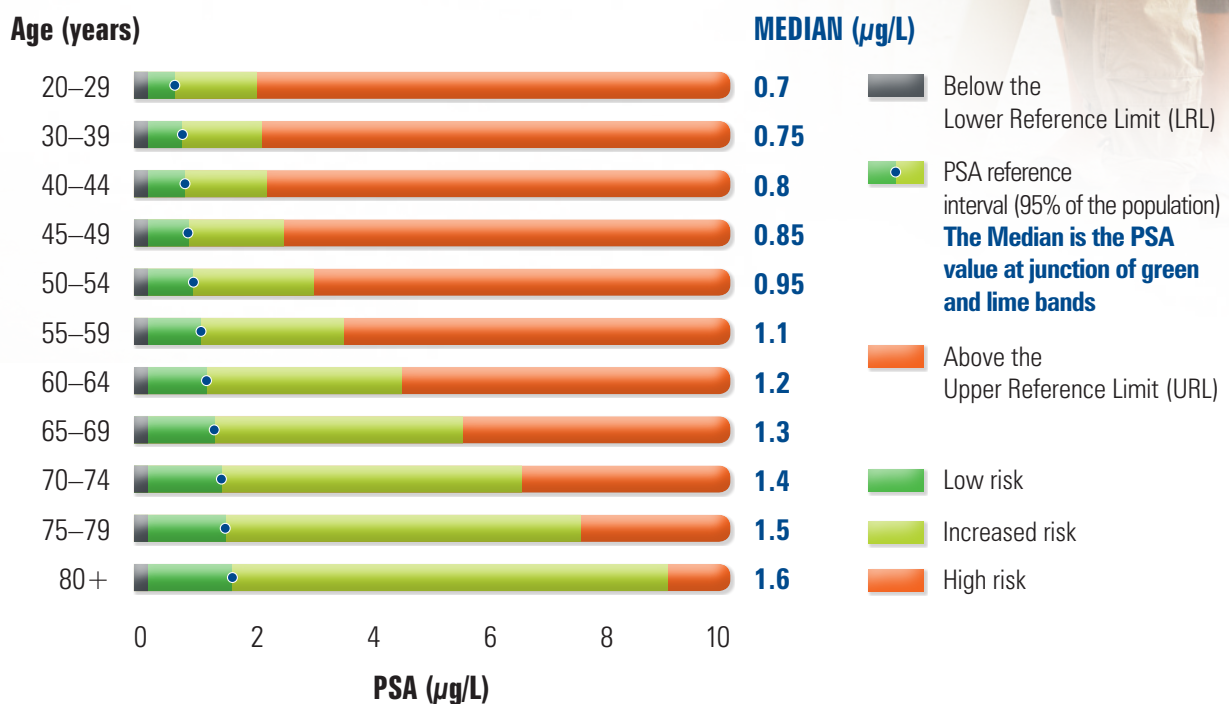


Assessment of Prostate Disease

The latest advances in pathology testing

Prostate Specific Antigen (PSA) chart

Age-related PSA reference intervals are shown in dark green and lime, separated by the age-related median value (shown as a black dot). Results below the median value and lower reference limit (LRL) are shown in green/grey and indicate “below average risk” of prostate cancer. Results between the median and the URL (shown in lime) are associated with “above average risk”. Results above the upper reference limit (URL) but less than 10 μ g/L (shown in orange) are associated with “increased risk” of prostate cancer. Results of 10 μ g/L or above have “significantly increased risk” of prostate cancer.
